### **Biography of Kenneth Lewis Penley:**

The following information was documented from interviews with **Kenneth Lewis Penley** by Scotty Wagner and Ramon Bell in October and November of 2014.

Ken stated, “I started deer hunting in 1956 on Game Lands in the 9<sup>th</sup> Wildlife District. All the game I have taken has been there. Any game taken there is a trophy with the kill rate of 1 deer per 1,200 acres. The season is too long and the bag limit is too high. (“If you eat all the eggs, you will not have any chickens.”)

Ken started shooting local tournaments in 1986; Won first tournament in 1987.

Ken says: “It is hard to become a good shot; Easy to become a bad shot!

Just like life, bad habits are hard to break.

I shoot my hunting bow in “Bowhunter Freestyle” class.

My proudest accomplishment was tying for 1<sup>st</sup> Place at Union Grove in 1990.

Won 100+ Local Club Shoots.

Western Carolina Archery Circuit Champion 7 times..

State Champion-20 Yard Indoor – 1995.

State Champion NFAA Field: 1996; 1997; 1998; 1999; 2000.

NFAA Southeastern 20 Yard Indoor Champion: 1997 & 1998.

State Senior Games- 1<sup>st</sup> Place.

My favorite Archery Competition is NFAA Field Archery.

NFAA member for 25 years.

My wife, Nancy, has won more big tournaments than I have. The biggest being a battle with breast cancer. My battle has been with prostate cancer.

My advice to all is this: Love God; Serve Him while you can, because, there is no tomorrow.
